



RTX Network Systems and GoIP International enter into strategic alliance on the supply of infrastructure to telecom providers in Latin America.

RTX Network Systems, a business unit within RTX Telecom A/S, which is listed on the OMX Nordic Stock Exchange Copenhagen, and GoIP International announce today that the two companies have entered into a strategic alliance on the supply of infrastructure and system elements for use in the establishment of telephony and data transfer.

The companies' joint solution will initially be offered in areas of Latin America that are not currently covered due to high establishment costs. The two companies have already concluded an agreement with a provider on delivery of their joint solution.

"In developed countries, we have come to expect broadband connections, high competition and, thus, low prices on telephony and data, but in many other places in the world, reality looks very different. Initiatives like distance education, for instance, are simply not possible due to extremely limited or no Internet access. And this means that the gap between those who have access to communication and those who don't is growing bigger and bigger every day," explains Tage Rasmussen, CEO for RTX Telecom A/S.

He calls attention to the combination of RTX Networks System's market-leading infrastructure for the establishment of last mile wireless with GoIP International's 'Voice in a Box' system which makes it possible to establish telephony and data transfer in financially weak areas with financial benefits for the providers.

"The partnership with RTX Telecom represents another milestone in GoIP's strategy to offer unique telecommunications solutions to telecom service providers in Latin America, where there is huge growth potential," says Stig Skaugvoll.

"In our experience, it is important that we can act as sparing partners for small providers in all aspects of their solutions, and this is possible with a partnership with GoIP, which in addition to its unique 'VoIP in a Box' system can also supply attractive agreements on access points for the traffic that our combined solution generates. I am really looking forward to working with GoIP," says Jørgen Skov Rosenkilde, Vice President of RTX Network Systems.
